






# **Firearm Injury Data**




## Youth (<18) Firearm Injuries

#### From Indianapolis Youth Firearm Survivors

*"It's been more difficult. It's gonna be that way, b/c the things you used to do, you can't do anymore. And that kinda hurts. So you go through your life hurting behind your tragedy."* 

*"I didn't really rely on the doctor, I relied on my mom a lot. It's just a thing about me with other people. I don't trust a lot of people and with that situation, it just really boosted up my anxiety a lot, and upped the ante for me not to trust people more."* 

"I told them in the group this, any my counselors and everything, they had no answer. What do I do when I'm out with my family? B/c like I said, I wanna go on my trips, I wanna go to the pool, I wanna go out to eat, I wanna go to baseball. And I'll walk, and it's one thing if I see him [offender] from a distance. It'll be like 'Oh, ya'll we gotta go.' It's another thing when I'm up and I look up, and he [offender] see me. Then its like, ' damn."
